### **a. Speed Limit Review and Speed Monitoring**

- c. Concern had been voiced by the golf club regarding travellers moving onto the golf course. The parish council would not give approval to a barrier. There used to be a ditch to prevent access and this was felt to be a more natural deterrent.
- d. The Golf Club is still looking into reduced fees for villagers as a goodwill gesture.
